Position Summary

The Assistant Dairy Manager supports the Dairy Manager in the daily operation of the dairy. This position helps oversee animal care, employee supervision, milking operations, feeding coordination, herd health, facility maintenance, and compliance with company safety and animal welfare standards. The Assistant Dairy Manager leads by example, ensuring that employees have the training, tools, and support necessary to achieve production, quality, and animal care goals. The role requires strong leadership, communication, organization, and problem-solving skills.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Herd Management

- Monitor daily cow health, comfort, and welfare.
- Assist with reproduction, fresh cow management, and transition cow programs.
- Work with veterinarians, nutritionists, and management teams to implement herd health protocols.
- Monitor milk production, SCC, and other performance indicators.
- Ensure timely identification and treatment of sick animals.

Milking Operations

- Oversee daily milking procedures and employee performance.
- Ensure compliance with milk quality standards and SOPs.
- Monitor parlor efficiency, cleanliness, and equipment functionality.
- Assist in training milking personnel on proper procedures and animal handling.

Employee Leadership

- Assist in hiring, onboarding, and training new employees.

- Computer proficiency, including dairy management software and Microsoft Office.
